

THE WEIGHTS AND MEASURES PROCLAMATION 1946

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 9 of the Weights and Measures Act, 1925, I, Sir Michael Myers, the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare as follows :---

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Weights and Measures Proclamation 1946.

2. The fluid ounce shall be a lawful measure of capacity and a new denomination of standard within the meaning of the Weights and Measures Act, 1925.

3. The fluid ounce shall be the one-hundred-and-sixtieth part of a gallon—that is to say, the fifth part of a gill.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the seal of that Dominion, this 6th day of May, 1946.
