PURSUANT to the Weights and Measures Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Weights and Measures Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Weights and Measures Regulations 1987* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of March 1991.

2. New scale of fees substituted—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Weights and Measures Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

3. Revocation—Regulation 4 of, and the Schedule to, the Weights and Measures Regulations 1987, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

The effect of the amendment is to increase the fees prescribed for various matters under the principal regulations. The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
