



**THE WAGE ADJUSTMENT REGULATIONS 1974,
AMENDMENT NO. 17**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 27th day of November 1978

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 17, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Part IIIA of the principal regulations not to expire with 31 December 1978—The following regulations are hereby revoked, namely:

- (a) Regulation 45E of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 8):
- (b) Regulation 2 of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 15.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations revoke the provision of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974 which provides that Part IIIA of those regulations (which relates to redundancy) expires with 31 December 1978. There is now no expiry date applicable to Part IIIA.
