ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of September 1983

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 23, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 27th day of September 1983.
- 2. Exceptions—(1) Regulation 45H of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 21) is hereby amended by inserting, after paragraph (c), the following paragraph:

"(ca) The fixing of any compensation for redundancy by an instrument described in paragraph 64 of the Fourth Schedule to the Wage Freeze Regulations 1982; or".

(2) Regulation 45H (d) is hereby consequentially amended by inserting, after the words "or paragraph (c)", the words "or paragraph (ca)".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 27 September 1983, add a further exception to Part IIIA of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974.

Part IIIA limits the amount that an employer may pay to a redundant employee by way of compensation for redundancy.
