PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 24, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 25th day of January 1984.

**2. Saving in respect of approval of certain redundancy provisions—**Part IIIA of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 3 of the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974, Amendment No. 20) is hereby amended by inserting, after regulation 451, the following regulation:

“451A. For the purposes only of—

“(a) Any application (whether made before or after the commencement of this regulation) provided for by regulation 451 of these regulations for the approval of provisions relating to the making of payments by way of compensation for redundancy to redundant employees of Nelsons (N.Z.) Limited, being provisions contained in an agreement dated the 7th day of December 1983 between that company and the Auckland and Tomoana Freezing Works, Abattoir and Related Trades Employees Industrial Union of Workers and being provisions which apply only in respect of redundancies that arise from the introduction of new technology; and

“(b) The implementation and enforcement of any such provisions approved by the Arbitration Court;

Nelsons (N.Z.) Limited shall be deemed to be a party to the redundancy agreement dated the 7th day of April 1982 and made between the Auckland Branch of the New Zealand Engineering, Coachbuilding, Aircraft, Motor and Related Trades Industrial Union of Workers and the Auckland Farmers' Freezing Cooperative Limited, the Westfield Freezing Company Limited, the Gisborne Refrigerating Company Limited, Aotearoa Meats (N.Z.) Limited, and R. and W. Hellaby Limited.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

This amendment amends the Wage Adjustment Regulations 1974 to provide that for limited purposes in relation to redundancy compensation arising from the introduction of new technology in the meat processing industry, Nelsons (N.Z.) Limited is deemed to be a party to an agreement dated 7 April 1982.
