**THE WATER AND SOIL CONSERVATION REGULATIONS 1968,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 31st day of March 1970

THE RIGHT HON. KEITH HOLYOAKE, C.H., PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Water and Soil Conservation Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Water and Soil Conservation Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Notices of existing dams and existing uses, etc., of water—Subclause (1) of regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting from paragraph (c) the words “by that person”;
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (d) the words “before the 9th day of September 1966 or is authorised by any Act”, and substituting the words “before the 1st day of April 1968”;
- (c) By omitting from paragraph (e) the words “before the 9th day of September 1966 or is authorised by any Act”, and substituting the words “before the 1st day of April 1968”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations are consequential upon the amendments made by the Water and Soil Conservation Amendment Act 1969, and relate to the giving of notice of existing uses of water and to the dates of Orders in Council authorising such uses.
