**THE WATER AND SOIL CONSERVATION REGULATIONS 1968,

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 27th day of February 1978

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Water and Soil Conservation Regulations 1968, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Water and Soil Conservation Regulations 1968* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Applications for rights in respect of water—Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "four dollars", and substituting the expression "\$30".

These regulations increase the fee for an application for a water right from \$4 to \$30.
