**THE WOOL BOARD (TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE)
REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day of August 1953

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Board (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Board (Travelling Allowance) Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulations 3, 4, and 5, and substituting the following regulation:

“3. (1) Where any member of the Board or of any Committee appointed by the Board is required to be absent from his usual place of residence for the purpose of attending any meeting of the Board or, with the approval of the Board, of transacting any business of the Board, there shall be paid to that member a subsistence allowance at such rate as the Minister of Finance from time to time approves in that behalf.

“(2) When the member, for any such purpose, is required to make any journey and he travels by public conveyance there shall be paid to him all fares and other expenses of locomotion incurred by him in making the journey.

“(3) Where a private means of conveyance is used for any such journey there shall be paid to the member a mileage allowance at such rate as the Minister of Finance from time to time approves in that behalf.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

These regulations provide that the rates of travelling allowances and mileage allowances for members of the Wool Board are to be those fixed by the Minister of Finance.
