THE WOOL BOARD ELECTION REGULATIONS 1946,  
AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of May 1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act 1944, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. **Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Wool Board Election Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Board Election Regulations 1946\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. **Receipt of nominations**—Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (3), and substituting the following subclause.

“(3) Nominations shall be received at such time and in such manner as the Board determines.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations allow the New Zealand Wool Board to determine the time and manner in which nominations of candidates for election are to be received. Previously nominations closed at the time appointed for the closing of nominations of candidates for election as producers' representatives on the New Zealand Meat Producers Board.
