A PROCLAMATION

Whereas by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Wool Commission Act 1951 it is provided that that Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed for the commencement thereof by the Governor-General by Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows:—

- 1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Wool Commission Act Commencement Order 1951.
- 2. The Wool Commission Act 1951 shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-two.
