**THE WOOL COMMISSION ACT COMMENCEMENT ORDER 1951**

FREYBERG, Governor-General

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Wool Commission Act 1951 it is provided that that Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed for the commencement thereof by the Governor-General by Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, Bernard Cyril, Baron Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows:—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Wool Commission Act Commencement Order 1951.

2. The Wool Commission Act 1951 shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and fifty-two.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the seal of that Dominion, this 17th day of December 1951.
