Pursuant to the Local Government Commission Act 1967 and the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Waitomo County Council Harbour Board (Mokau Harbour Board) Order 1972.
- 2. Harbour Board abolished—The Waitomo County Council shall cease to exercise or perform the powers, functions, duties, and authorities imposed by section 5 of the Mokau Harbour Act 1940, and shall cease to be deemed to be a harbour board.
- 3. Vesting of property—All the property, real and personal, vested in the Corporation of the County of Waitomo for the estate or interest of the Mokau Harbour Board shall be vested in the Waitomo County Council absolutely.
- 4. Consequential amendment—The Harbours Act 1950 is hereby amended by omitting from the Second Schedule (as substituted by section 12 (1) of the Harbours Amendment Act 1965) the words "Mokau Harbour Board".
