PURSUANT to section 30 of the Wanganui Computer Centre Act 1976,
His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice
and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the
Wanganui Computer Centre Order 1981.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its
notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Community service records—(1) The computer system may be
used for the storage, processing, and retrieval of the information
specified in the Schedule to this order.

(2) The storage, processing, and retrieval of the information specified
in the Schedule to this order is subject to the conditions specified in
relation thereto in that Schedule.
