Pursuant to section 30 of the Wanganui Computer Centre Act 1976, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Wanganui Computer Centre Order 1981.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Community service records—(1) The computer system may be used for the storage, processing, and retrieval of the information specified in the Schedule to this order.
- (2) The storage, processing, and retrieval of the information specified in the Schedule to this order is subject to the conditions specified in relation thereto in that Schedule.
