ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 17th day of June 1968

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Hospitals Act 1957, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the West Coast Hospital District Order 1967, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the West Coast Hospital District Order 1967* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Commencement of Part I of principal order—Clause 1 of the principal order (as amended by the West Coast Hospital District Order 1967, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "1st day of July", and substituting the words "1st day of August".

3. Revocation—The West Coast Hospital District Order 1967, Amendment No. 2, is hereby revoked.
