

THE WORK CENTRE (HUNTLY) NOTICE 1989

PURSUANT to section 126 (1) of the Criminal Justice Act 1985, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Work Centre (Huntly) Notice 1989.

(2) This notice shall take effect from the 1st day of October 1989.

2. Constitution of Huntly Work Centre—The land described in the Schedule to this notice is hereby declared to be a work centre, to be known as the Huntly Work Centre.

All that piece of land in the South Auckland Land District containing 646 square metres, more or less, situated in the Borough of Huntly, being Lot 1 on Deposited Plan S. 30813, and being part Allotments 53 and 53A, Parish of Taupiri and part Lot 6 on Deposited Plan 11170 [Excepting however from those parcels of land formerly parts Allotments 6 and 53, coloured red and green on certificates of title, Volume 696, folio 175, and Volume 696, folio 178 respectively, all coal and other minerals beneath the surface of the said land], and being the whole of the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Volume 28A, folio 225, South Auckland Registry.
