THE WAIPORI CEMETERY ORDER 1977

PURSUANT to section 24 (1) of the Burial and Cremation Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Waipori Cemetery Order 1977.

2. Delegation of powers—The powers conferred on the Governor-General by subsections (1) and (2) of section 23 of the Burial and Cremation Act 1964, so far as they are exercisable in respect of the Waipori Cemetery (being the land described in the Schedule to this order), are hereby delegated to the Tuapeka County Council.

3. Revocations and amendments—(1) The notice relating to the appointment of trustees of the said cemetery, given on the 9th day of February 1907 and published in the *Gazette*, 1907, Vol. 1, p. 572, is hereby consequentially revoked.

(2) The Order in Council relating to the delegation of certain powers under the Cemeteries Act 1908, made on the 18th day of September 1933 and published in the *Gazette*, 1933, Vol. 3, p. 2429, is hereby consequentially amended by revoking so much of the Schedule as relates to the said cemetery.
