THE HON. J. R. HANAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Commission Act 1951, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Commission Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Commission Regulations 1952\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2) (as substituted by the Wool Commission Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 7), and substituting the following subclause:

- “(2) The rate of the charge shall be—  
 “(a) For each bale, 7s. 6d.:  
 “(b) For each fadge, 3s. 9d.:  
 “(c) For each bag or sack, 1s. 3d.”

(2) This regulation shall apply where the wool in respect of which the charge is payable is sold, delivered, or exported, as the case may be, on or after the 1st day of October 1962.

(3) The Wool Commission Regulations 1952, Amendment No. 7, are hereby consequentially revoked.
