Order

1 Title

- (1) This order is the Water Conservation (Motueka River) Amendment Order 2006.
- (2) In this order, the Water Conservation (Motueka River) Order 2004 is called “the principal order”.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3 Restrictions on alteration of water quality

Clause 11(2)(d) of the principal order is amended by inserting, after the word “does”, the word “not”.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, amends the Water Conservation (Motueka River) Order 2004. The amendment corrects the E coli allowance standard for resource consents in relation to the waters covered by the Water Conservation (Motueka River) Order 2004.
