Pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act 1954, the Minister of Justice hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Work Centres (Dunedin, Wanganui, and Gisborne) Notice 1972.
 - (2) This notice shall take effect from the 11th day of May 1972.
- 2. Dunedin Adult Work Centre—The land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a work centre to be known as the Dunedin Adult Work Centre.
- 3. Wanganui Work Centre—The land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a work centre to be known as the Wanganui Work Centre.
- 4. Gisborne Work Centre—The land described in the Third Schedule hereto is hereby declared to be a work centre to be known as the Gisborne Work Centre.

FIRST SCHEDULE

DUNEDIN ADULT WORK CENTRE
