THE WOOL DISPOSAL COMMISSION (TRAVELLING-ALLOWANCE) REGULATIONS 1946

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 10th day of April, 1946

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to the Wool Disposal Act, 1945, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Disposal Commission (Travelling-allowance) Regulations 1946.
- 2. The Travelling-allowance Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the said regulations) shall apply to and be deemed to be incorporated in these regulations so as to relate to the New Zealand Wool Disposal Commission established under the Wool Disposal Act, 1945, and the members of the Commission or of any Committee appointed by the Commission.
- 3. The rate of the subsistence allowance referred to in Regulation 4 of the said regulations shall be £1 10s. a day.
- 4. The rate of the mileage-allowance referred to in Regulation 11 of the said regulations for journeys performed in a motor-vehicle shall—
 - (a) Where the horse-power of the vehicle does not exceed 9½, be 5d. a mile:
 - (b) Where the horse-power of the vehicle exceeds 9½ but does not exceed 14½, be 5¾d. a mile:
 - (c) Where the horse-power of the vehicle exceeds $14\frac{1}{2}$, be $6\frac{1}{4}$ d. a mile.
- 5. The amount payable in respect of actual garage expenses referred to in Regulation 11 of the said regulations shall not exceed 2s. 6d. a night.
