THE WAR DAMAGE REGULATIONS 1941, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 25th day of March, 1942.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the War Damage Act, 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the War Damage Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Damage Regulations 1941* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 5, the following regulation :---

"5A. Section 14 of the Act shall not apply with respect to any ship within the meaning of the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942[†] to which clause 3 or clause 4 of those regulations for the time being applies."

3. Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words "for every day or part of a day", and substituting the words "a day, with a proportionate part of that amount for every part of a day".
