## ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 25th day of  
March, 1942.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the War Damage Act, 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the War Damage Regulations 1941, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Damage Regulations 1941\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting, after Regulation 5, the following regulation :—

“ 5A. Section 14 of the Act shall not apply with respect to any ship within the meaning of the Marine Insurance (War Risks) Emergency Regulations 1942† to which clause 3 or clause 4 of those regulations for the time being applies.”

3. Regulation 15 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (2) the words “ for every day or part of a day ”, and substituting the words “ a day, with a proportionate part of that amount for every part of a day ”.
