**THE WOOL DISPOSAL REGULATIONS 1947,
AMENDMENT NO. 2**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Disposal Act, 1945, and after taking into consideration the advice tendered to the Minister of Marketing by the New Zealand Wool Disposal Commission, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Disposal Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Disposal Regulations 1947* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Regulation 10 of the principal regulations, as amended by the Wool Disposal Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, is hereby further amended by omitting the words "5 per cent." wherever those words occur, and substituting in each case the words "2½ per cent."

(2) The regulations cited as the Wool Disposal Regulations 1947, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

3. The said Regulation 10 as in force before the making of these regulations shall apply with respect to the contributory charge on all wool produced in New Zealand which was sold by a broker, delivered to a manufacturer or scourer, or exported as provided in subsection (1) of section 17 of the Act at any time before the 22nd day of July, 1949, as if these regulations had not been made.
