1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Waitemata Electric Power Board Elections Regulations Revocation Order 1968.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1968.

2. Revocation—The Waitemata Electric Power Board Elections Regulations 1963* are hereby revoked.
