

# THE WHITEBAIT FISHING (WEST COAST) REGULATIONS 1994, AMENDMENT NO. 1

### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 17th day of October 1994

#### Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 48 and 48A of the Conservation Act 1987, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Whitebait Fishing (West Coast) Regulations 1994, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Whitebait Fishing (West Coast) Regulations 1994\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Closed season to begin on 15 November 1994—Notwithstanding regulation 4 of the principal regulations, any person may—
  - (a) Fish for whitebait in any waters or places to which those regulations apply; or

(b) Be in possession of any whitebait taken from any of those waters or places during the period beginning on the commencement of these regulations and ending with the close of the 14th day of November 1994.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Whitebait Fishing (West Coast) Regulations 1994 by postponing from 1 November to 15 November the commencement of the closed season that begins in 1994. The regulations do not affect any subsequent closed season.
