

# THE WILDLIFE (CANADA GOOSE) ORDER 1970

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 23rd day of February 1970

Pursuant to the Wildlife Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the Wildlife (Canada Goose) Order 1970.
- 2. Canada goose to be game in certain areas—It is hereby declared that Canada goose (Branta canadensis) shall be game in the following areas in addition to the area specified in the First Schedule to the Wildlife Act 1953, namely:

(a) That area of land and water comprising the Waitaki River from the top of the Lake Waitaki Dam to the sea, the bed of that portion of the Waitaki River, and all islands in that portion:

(b) That portion of the Waitaki Valley Acclimatisation District that lies to the eastward of the South Island Main Trunk Railway line.

3. Revocation and amendment—(1) The Wildlife (Canada Goose) Order 1966\* is hereby revoked.

(2) Clause 3 of the Wildlife (Canada Goose) Order 1959† is hereby amended by inserting, after the words "Wildlife Act 1953", the words "or in clause 2 of the Wildlife (Canada Goose) Order 1970".
