# THE WESTPORT HARBOUR REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 4

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

## REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Westport Harbour Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Westport Harbour Regulations 1965\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Wharfage Rates—The principal regulations are hereby amended by inserting in regulation 82 (as substituted by regulation 10 of the Westport Harbour Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 3), after the expression "Coal for shipment other than export free", the expression "Coal for export, per tonne (1,000 kg) 0.50".

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This amendment specifies a wharfage charge of 50c per tonne for coal loaded for export which would otherwise be charged at 98c per tonne under the heading "On all goods not otherwise specified".
