Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the Weathertight Homes Resolution Services (Lower-value Ceiling) Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2007.

3 Lower-value ceiling prescribed

The value prescribed under section 123(b) of the Weathertight Homes Resolution Services Act 2006 is \$20,000.

4 GST included

The value prescribed by regulation 3 is inclusive of goods and services tax (if any).

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2007, are made under the Weathertight Homes Resolution Services Act 2006. They prescribe a value to be a ceiling for determining how claims are to be dealt with. (The value affects whether a claim is, for the purposes of the Act, a lower-value claim.) The value, referred to in the Act as the lower-value ceiling, is \$20,000.
