**THE WOOL INDUSTRY ACT COMMENCEMENT ORDER 1944**

**A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Wool Industry Act, 1944, it is provided that that Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed for the commencement thereof by the Governor-General by Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows:—

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Wool Industry Act Commencement Order 1944.

2. The Wool Industry Act, 1944, shall come into force on the 11th day of January, 1945.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the seal of that Dominion, this 14th day of December, 1944.
