A PROCLAMATION

Whereas by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Wool Industry Act, 1944, it is provided that that Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed for the commencement thereof by the Governor-General by Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, Cyril Louis Norton Newall, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim as follows:—

- 1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Wool Industry Act Commencement Order 1944.
- 2. The Wool Industry Act, 1944, shall come into force on the 11th day of January, 1945.

Given under the hand of His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, and issued under the seal of that Dominion, this 14th day of December, 1944.
