**THE WATERFRONT INDUSTRY EMERGENCY REGULATIONS  
1946, AMENDMENT NO. 4**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Waterfront Industry Emergency Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Waterfront Emergency Regulations 1946\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as enacted by Regulation 4 of the Waterfront Industry Emergency Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 3, is hereby amended by revoking subclause (2), and substituting the following subclause:—

“(2) At all meetings of the Commission three members, of whom one shall be the Chairman or the Government member, shall form a quorum.”

3. The said Regulation 5 is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (5), and substituting the following subclause:—

“(5) At all meetings of the Commission the Chairman shall have a deliberative vote, and in the case of an equality of votes shall also have a casting vote.”
