PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act, 1947, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- These regulations may be cited as the Waterfront Industry Emergency Regulations 1946, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Waterfront Industry Emergency Regulations 1946* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. (1) The Minister may from time to time, by order in writing, suspend in whole or in part all or any of the provisions of the principal regulations or of any order, direction, or decision made by the Authority or by the Commission or by any Port Committee under the principal regulations in respect of their application to all or any of the ports in New Zealand, and may at any time or from time to time revoke or vary any such order.
- (2) Any such order made by the Minister under this regulation shall be published in the *Gazette*; but every such order shall, unless otherwise provided therein, take effect on the day of the making thereof.
