THE WHALING INDUSTRY REGULATIONS 1961,
AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 21st day of July 1975

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 16 of the Whaling Industry Act 1935, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Whaling Industry Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Whaling Industry Regulations 1961* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Minimum sizes—Regulation 10 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 4 of the Whaling Industry Regulations 1961, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting the expressions “70 ft”, “57 ft”, “40 ft”, “38 ft”, “65 ft”, “55 ft”, and “35 ft” wherever they occur, and by omitting the parentheses from every measurement expressed in metres.

3. Measurement of length—Regulation 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “Measurements, after being accurately read on the tape measure, shall be logged to the nearest foot, that is to say, any whale between 35 ft 6 in. and 36 ft 6 in. shall be logged as 36 ft, and any whale between 36 ft 6 in. and 37 ft 6 in. shall be logged as 37 ft. The measurement of any whale which falls on an exact half foot shall be logged at the next half foot, that is to say 36 ft

6 in. precisely, shall be logged as 37 ft.”, and substituting the words “Measurements, after being accurately read on the tape measure, shall be logged to the nearest tenth of a metre, that is to say, any whale between 10.15 m and 10.25 m shall be logged as 10.2 m, and any whale between 10.25 m and 10.35 m shall be logged as 10.3 m. The measurement of any whale which falls on an exact 5 cm shall be logged at the next tenth of a metre, that is to say 10.15 m precisely shall be logged as 10.2 m”.

4. Schedule amended—The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from the Schedule to both Form 2 and Form 4 the heading “Horsepower”, and substituting in both cases the heading “Power in Kilowatts”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the Whaling Industry Regulations 1961 and its amendment by making metric conversions.
