PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wool Industry Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Industry Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1983.

2. Rate of funding levy—Regulation 3 (1) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 of the Wool Industry Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression "1 percent" (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Wool Industry Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2), in both places where it occurs, and substituting, in each case, the expression "2 percent".

3. Revocation—The Wool Industry Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2 are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations restore the rate of the levy on wool that funds the minimum prices scheme from 1 percent to 2 percent. In 1980, it was reduced from 2 percent to 1 percent by the Wool Industry Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 2.
