1 Title

This order is the Wildlife (Rainbow Lorikeet) Order 2001.

2 Commencement

This order comes into force on 1 October 2001.

3 Unprotected wildlife

The Fifth Schedule of the Wildlife Act 1953 is amended by inserting, after the item "Pigeon—Rock pigeon (Columbia

livia)", the item "Rainbow lorikeet (Trichoglossus haematodus)".

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 1 October 2001, adds rainbow lorikeet to the Fifth Schedule of the Wildlife Act 1953. The Fifth Schedule lists the wildlife that is not protected under that Act. The effect of the order is to remove absolute protection under the Act for rainbow lorikeet.
