**THE WOOL LEVY REGULATIONS 1945, AMENDMENT NO. 1**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of  
April, 1948

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act, 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Levy Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed to form part of the Wool Levy Regulations 1945\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked, and the following regulation substituted :—

“ 4. The maximum rates of the levy that may be charged on wool pursuant to section 12 of the said Act shall be—

“ (a) For each bale, 5s.

“ (b) For each fadge, 2s. 6d.

“ (c) For each bag or sack, 10d.”
