THE WOOL LEVY REGULATIONS 1945, AMENDMENT NO. 2

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 3rd day of September 1962

Present:

THE HON. J. R. HANAN PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act 1944, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Wool Levy Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Levy Regulations 1945* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

2. (1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 4 (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Wool Levy Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1) and substituting the following regulation:

“4. The maximum rates of the levy that may be charged on wool pursuant to section 12 of the said Act shall be—

“(a) For each bale	7	6
“(b) For each fadge	3	9
“(c) For each bag or sack	1	3”

(2) The Wool Levy Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations prescribe the maximum rate of levy that may be charged on wool pursuant to section 12 of the Wool Industry Act 1944.
