THE WOOL LEVY REGULATIONS 1945, AMENDMENT NO. 4

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of June 1970

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Wool Industry Act 1944, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title—These regulations may be cited as the Wool Levy Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wool Levy Regulations 1945* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Maximum rate of wool levy—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 (1) of the Wool Levy Regulations 1945, Amendment No. 3 and amended by section 7 (1) of the Decimal Currency Act 1964) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression "0.7c", and substituting the expression "1c".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase from 0.7c per lb to 1c per lb the maximum rate of levy that may be charged on wool under section 12 of the Wool Industry Act 1944.
