Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL Pursuant to section 31 of the Wine Makers Act 1981, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Wine Makers Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Wine Makers Regulations 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. New scale of fees substituted—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
- (2) Regulation 3 (4) of the Wine Makers Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 1 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

The regulations increase the fees payable on application for the grant or renewal of a wine maker's licence or for the grant of a wine maker's bar permit. They also prescribe a new fee payable on the grant of a special permit for social gatherings in vineyards, regardless of the number of gatherings to be held. At present, the fee differs according to whether there is to be one or more than one such gathering. Finally, the regulations prescribe a new fee payable on application for the removal of a wine maker's licence. No such fee is presently prescribed.
