

## THE WILDLIFE (PEAFOWL) NOTICE 1961

Pursuant to section 6 of the Wildlife Act 1953, the Minister of Internal Affairs hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

- 1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Wildlife (Peafowl) Notice 1961.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its notification in the Gazette.
  - (3) This notice shall apply throughout New Zealand.
- 2. In this notice the term "peafowl" means any bird of the species Pavo cristatus.
- 3. No person shall hunt or kill any peafowl on any land of which he is not the occupier, except with the prior consent in writing of the occupier of that land.
