Pursuant to section 96 of the War Pensions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

- (1) These regulations are the War Pensions Amendment Regulations 2001.
- (2) In these regulations, the War Pensions Regulations 1956¹ are called “the principal regulations”.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2001.

3 Increasing travelling allowances

Regulation 44 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “\$17.76”, and substituting the expression “\$18.47”.

4 Increasing maximum rates of war bursaries

- (1) Clause 1 of Schedule 6 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expressions “\$643.97”, “\$764.16”, and “\$160.98”, and substituting the expressions “\$669.60”, “\$794.57”, and “\$167.39” respectively.
- (2) Clause 2 of Schedule 6 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expressions “\$321.98”, “\$382.07”, and “\$160.98”, and substituting the expressions “\$334.79”, “\$397.28”, and “\$167.39” respectively.

5 Increasing maximum amounts of motor vehicle loans

Schedule 8 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting from the second column the expressions “\$13,210.69” and “\$5,945.19”, and substituting the expressions “\$13,736.48” and “\$6,181.81” respectively.

6 Increasing allowance payable for decorations if receiving disablement pension

Schedule 10 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “\$7.74” in each place where it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “\$8.05”.

7 Increasing annuity payable to holders of Victoria Cross

Schedule 11 of the principal regulations is amended by omitting the expression “\$1,548.71”, and substituting the expression “\$1,610.35”.

8 Revocation

The War Pensions Amendment Regulations 2000 (SR 2000/45) are revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2001, amend the War Pensions Regulations 1956 by increasing the following in accordance with the All Groups Consumer Price Index of 3.98%:

- the rate of weekly travelling allowance:
 - the maximum rates of war bursaries payable to secondary school students and students of colleges of education, polytechnics, universities, and wananga:
 - the maximum amounts of motor vehicle loans:
 - the weekly allowance payable to holders of certain specified decorations who are in receipt of war disablement pensions:
 - the annuity payable to holders of the Victoria Cross.
