Pursuant to section 96 of the War Pensions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the advice and with the consent of the Executive Council, makes the following regulations.

Regulations

1 Title

These regulations are the War Pensions Amendment Regulations 2007.

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 April 2007.

3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the War Pensions Regulations 1956.

4 Travelling allowances

Regulation 44 is amended by omitting “\$20.79” and substituting “\$21.34”.

5 Maximum rates of war bursaries

- (1) Clause 1 of Schedule 6 is amended by omitting “\$753.47”, “\$894.10”, and “\$188.36” and substituting “\$773.29”, “\$917.61”, and “\$193.31” respectively.
- (2) Clause 2 of Schedule 6 is amended by omitting “\$376.72”, “\$447.03”, and “\$188.36” and substituting “\$386.63”, “\$458.79”, and “\$193.31” respectively.

6 Maximum amounts of motor vehicle loans

Schedule 8 is amended by omitting from the second column “\$15,457” and “\$6,956.11” and substituting “\$15,863.52” and “\$7,139.06” respectively.

7 Allowance payable for decorations if receiving disablement pension

Schedule 10 is amended by omitting “\$9.06” in each place where it appears and substituting in each case “\$9.30”.

8 Annuity payable to holders of Victoria Cross

Schedule 11 is amended by omitting “\$1,812.06” and substituting “\$1,859.72”.

9 Revocation

The War Pensions Amendment Regulations 2006 (SR 2006/42) are revoked.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 2007, amend the War Pensions Regulations 1956 by increasing the following in accordance with an increase of 2.63% in the All Groups Consumers Price Index:

- the rate of weekly travelling allowance:
 - the maximum rates of war bursaries payable to secondary school students and students of colleges of education, polytechnics, specialist colleges, universities, and wananga:
 - the maximum amounts of motor vehicle loans:
 - the weekly allowance payable to holders of certain specified decorations who are in receipt of war disablement pensions:
 - the annuity payable to holders of the Victoria Cross.
