THE WAR PENSIONS EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1944

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 19th day
of July, 1944

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the War Pensions Emergency Regulations 1944.

2. (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "the Act" means the War Pensions Act, 1943.

(2) For the purposes of the general interpretation thereof, these regulations shall be deemed to be made under the Act.

3. (1) For the purposes of the Act there may from time to time be appointed in accordance with section 5 of the Act such number of additional War Pensions Boards as the Minister thinks fit.

(2) Whenever any additional Board is in existence under this regulation,—

(a) The provisions of the Act and of any regulations made under the Act relating to the War Pensions Board shall apply with respect to the additional Board :

(b) References in the Act or in any regulations made under the Act to the War Pensions Board shall be deemed to include references to the additional Board :

(c) The Minister may assign to the original Board and to the additional Board such distinctive names as he thinks fit.

4. (1) For the purposes of the Act there may from time to time be appointed in accordance with section 8 of the Act such number of additional War Pensions Appeal Boards as the Minister thinks fit.

(2) Whenever any additional Board is in existence under this regulation,—

- (a) The provisions of the Act and of any regulations made under the Act relating to the War Pensions Appeal Board shall apply with respect to the additional Board :
- (b) References in the Act or in any regulations made under the Act to the War Pensions Appeal Board shall be deemed to include references to the additional Board :
- (c) The Minister may assign to the original Board and to the additional Board such distinctive names as he thinks fit.
