#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 26th day of March 1984

#### Present:

THE RIGHT HON. SIR ROBERT MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 75c of the War Pensions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the War Pensions (Rates and Allowances) Order 1984.
- (2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 18th day of January 1984.
- 2. Increasing rates of certain pensions and allowances on and after 18 January 1984—Each provision of the War Pensions Act 1954 specified in the first column of the Schedule to this order is hereby amended by omitting every expression set out opposite to it in the second column of that Schedule, wherever that expression occurs, and substituting in each case the expression set out opposite to it in the third column of that Schedule.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the rates of the following pensions and allowances on and after 18 January 1984.

(a) Economic pensions payable in conjunction with-

(i) Disablement pensions:

(ii) Widows' pensions; and

(iii) Widowed mothers' pensions.

(b) Wives' pensions:

(c) War veterans' allowances and war veterans' allowance gratuities:

(d) War service pensions:

(e) War orphans' pensions.

The increase is \$1.58 a week for unmarried persons and \$2.64 a week for married couples. The additional amount payable for the first child of a solo parent pensioner is increased by \$1.06 to \$54.82 a week.

The rate of orphans' pensions is increased by 75c to \$46.05 a week.
