#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

## At the Government House at Wellington this 3rd day of September 1985

#### HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 75c of the War Pensions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the War Pensions (Rates of Pensions and Allowances) Order (No. 2) 1985.

(2) This order shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.

2. Increasing rates of certain pensions and allowances on and after 1 April 1985—Each provision of the War Pensions Act 1954 specified in the first column of the Schedule to this order is hereby amended by omitting every expression set out opposite to it in the second column of that Schedule, wherever that expression occurs, and substituting in each case the expression set out opposite to it in the third column of that Schedule.

#### War Pensions (Rates of Pensions and Allowances) Order (No. 2) 1985

**3. Revocations**—The following orders are hereby consequentially revoked:

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases, on and after 1 April 1985, the following war pensions and allowances: (a) Maximum rate of disablement pensions, by \$9.23 to \$78.04 a week. This will also allow proportionate increases in pensions for partial disablement:

- (b) Maximum rate of additional pension in respect of cases of severe disablement, by \$5.53 to \$46.82 a week:
- (c) Maximum rate of allowances for services of attendants for disabled pensioners by \$17.09 to \$144.56 a week:

(d) Clothing allowances by \$1.03 to \$8.70 a week in respect of loss of 2 limbs, by 99c to \$8.39 a week in respect of loss of a leg, and by 72c to \$6.09 a week in respect of loss of an arm or use of a mechanical appliance or soiling of clothing:
(e) Maximum rate of war widows' pensions by \$6.81 to \$57.57 a week, and war veteran's allowance payable to a widow by \$6.81 to \$157.39 a week.
