At the Government House at Wellington this 19th day of November 1984

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 75c of the War Pensions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the War Pensions (Rates of Pensions and Allowances) Order (No. 5) 1984.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 5th day of December 1984.

2. Increasing rates of certain pensions and allowances on and after 5 December 1984—Each provision of the War Pensions Act 1954 specified in the first column of the Schedule to this order is hereby amended by omitting every expression set out opposite to it in the second column of that Schedule, wherever that expression occurs, and substituting in each case the expression set out opposite to it in the third column of that Schedule.

3. Revocation—The War Pensions (Rates of Pensions and Allowances) Order (No. 4) 1984* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the rates of the following pensions and allowances on and after 5 December 1984:

(a) Economic pensions payable in conjunction with-

(i) Disablement pensions;

(ii) Widows' pensions; and

(iii) Widowed mothers' pensions:

(b) Wives' pensions:

(c) War veterans' allowances and war veterans' allowance gratuities:

(d) War service pensions.

The increase is \$3.60 a week for unmarried persons and \$6 a week for married couples. The additional amount payable for each dependent child of a married couple and for the second and each subsequent dependent child of a solo parent pensioner is increased by \$2

to \$8 a week. The additional amount payable for the first or only dependent child of a solo parent pensioner is increased by \$2.40 to \$58.98 a week.

The rate of war orphans' pensions is increased by \$1.75 to \$49.10 a week.
