**THE WATER POWER REGULATIONS 1934, AMENDMENT
NO. 4**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 2nd day of July 1958

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Water Power Regulations 1934, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Water Power Regulations 1934* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. (1) Subclause (17) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (a), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) Provided the licensee has legal power so to do, the licensee will if so required sell to the Crown the licence together with the whole of the business and undertaking of the licensee so far as it relates to or is connected with the exercise of the licence, and together with all real and personal property and all rights vested in the licensee and used or engaged in connection with the business or undertaking so to be purchased (all hereafter in this subclause referred to as the undertaking).”

(2) Subclause (17) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby further amended—

(a) By revoking paragraph (b) :

(b) By omitting from paragraph (c) the words “or executed under the common seal of the Electric Power Board as the case may be”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend regulation 6 (17) of the Water Power Regulations 1934 so as to make the option to purchase certain electrical undertakings conferred by that provision exercisable only by the Crown.
