## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 24th day of September 1979

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electricity Act 1968, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Water Power Regulations 1934, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Water Power Regulations 1934\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Charges on sale—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 3.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations revoke regulation 3 of the Water Power Regulations 1934 relating to charges on sale of electricity by any person or organisation (including a Supply Authority) generating electricity under a licence.
