**THE WAR PENSIONS REGULATIONS 1956,
AMENDMENT NO. 3**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of August 1961

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the War Pensions Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the War Pensions Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the War Pensions Regulations 1956* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “before the Secretary of”, and substituting the words “before the Secretary or”.

3. Regulation 43 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting in subclause (1), after the words “total disablement”, the words “or who is and has continuously during the three years immediately past been in receipt of a temporary pension in respect of his total disablement”.

4. Regulation 44 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “in receipt of a permanent pension in respect of his total disablement who”, and substituting the words “who is in receipt of a permanent pension in respect of his total disablement or who is and has continuously during the three years immediately past been in receipt of a temporary pension in respect of his total disablement, and who in either case”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 corrects a clerical error in regulation 4 of the principal regulations.

Regulations 3 and 4 extend the present travel concessions, which at present are available to persons in receipt of permanent pensions in respect of total disablement, to persons who are and have for three years continuously been in receipt of temporary pensions in respect of total disablement.
